Five syllables in the first line

Seven syllables in the second line


Five syllables in the last line

## What is Haiku?


- \* an ancient form of Japanese poetry
- \* has 17 "moras" which are similar to syllables
- \* usually has a "kigo" which is a reference to one of the seasons
- \* are written in one vertical line of characters called "kanji" (Japanese words in calligraphy)
- \* usually focus on the natural world

By Masaoka Shiki (1867-1902), credited with reviving the haiku and developing its modern format (not complete)
